## *"Philippine Letter"*

Dear Friends,

Jesus called his Disciples "friends" one time after they had been together awhile. Do you realize how long most of you have been friends with Mary Ann and I! Every month when we place labels on the "Philippine Letter," we think about each one of you, and thank God that we are "Friends in Christ" helping each other do what Jesus has sent us to teach the lost, and Disciple them to do what you and I are doing. Thank you so much!

The new semester for our 4 PIBI Schools began June 16th, after a couple of weeks resting from many long hours and days teaching the Word during our "SEP" Summer Evangelism for 8 weeks. Mission churches were strengthened, and over 70 souls added to their number. Many "home Bible studies are still in progress. There were 21 of the 24 Faculty members totally involved leading the students, and giving aid to the 35 full time "Fieldworkers." (Evangelist are graduates of 3 year PIBI, who continue to Plant new churches, and train our students on weekends. Their school allowance continues as long as they continue to teach, preach, plant churches, They get supervised experience learning to be "followers," and also "leaders." (See the 3 year Bible Curriculum) About 20 graduates spend one year in "Fieldwork," and follow other fulltime pursuits, but they will be good assets for the Lord's Church where ever they may go.

We have Improved our program and remove the allowances from those "Fieldworkers," who are not "proving themselves" to be capable to do the work of an Evangelist. We now require weekly written reports of their teaching activities, and prospects, and baptisms. This report will perhaps tell us if this Fieldworker is really interested in spending his time teaching and preaching. The Administrators, and Faculty will examine each student's report, in order to encourage, and assist the students and Fieldworkers in becoming better teachers.
